

"I lived the life of prostitution and drug addiction all my

adult life. I am now 30 years old and I have been at Jasmine Road for 6 months now. I could tell you a bunch of sad stories about my childhood experiences and other ways I ended up here, but I would like you to know how much a difference Jasmine Road has made in my life. When I first came here I didn't know who I was or what I liked or what I was good at. In the past few months I started the process of healing from a **lifetime of hurt.** Today I have women in my life who unconditionally love and support me through everything. I know I will make mistakes, but I know they will be there holding my hand through it. The staff and the residents are family to me." - Jasmine Road Resident

Partner Spotlight:

#### **Christ Church Episcopal** The unique collaboration that launched Jasmine Road brought together three powerful faith partners, Christ Church Episcopal, Triune Mercy Center and Bon

Secours St. Francis Health System. Christ Church was a natural fit because of their history of involvement starting new entities such as The Greenville Free Medical Clinic, Project Host, Stephens House and United Ministries. Christ Church graciously continues to offer financial assistance, volunteer support, meeting space, encouragement and open arms without exerting ownership to the new ministry. Christ Church as a parish is embracing the women of Jasmine Road and joining them in kinship and community. They were instrumental in helping with

the purchase and renovation of the first home which provides the foundation of our

housing first program. Our first grant was from United Thank Offering of the

Episcopal Church to fund startup costs. The Episcopal Church Women (ECW) have provided significant grants for the past two years from their fundraising efforts. Dozens of volunteers regularly interact with the women of Jasmine Road to offer volunteer hours, meals, financial support, transportation, prayer, friendship, encouragement and compassion. This new community is a true expression of radical hospitality and welcoming the stranger with an open heart and mind. Our work has just begun but we know that the soil has been prepared, the seeds have been planted and the new community has sprouted. We look forward to continuing to nurture Jasmine Road as the vine grows and begins to bear fruit. While not a new problem, human trafficking is gaining awareness as we are learning how to identify victims and better understand their needs. Coordination between community partners including healthcare, law enforcement, non-profit service

resonate with the faith community because they intrinsically value serving the needs of vulnerable populations and have an intolerance for injustice. Women who have experienced trafficking have also most likely experienced childhood sex abuse, drug addiction, incarceration and homelessness and are trapped in a cycle that cannot be broken without powerful intervention. Lending help and caring about the outcome of these women is at the heart of what faith is all about - a belief that all people deserve dignity, freedom and respect, and caring for the most marginalized in our community. We are so grateful to Christ Church for leading the way.
